NEA Fund

The National Education Association Fund for Children and Public Education (NEA Fund) collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses those contributions for political purposes, including, but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for federal office. Contributions to the NEA Fund are voluntary; making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. Although the NEA Fund requests a minimum annual contribution of \$4.80, this is only a suggestion. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates.

Contributions or gifts to the NEA Fund are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year.

Federal law prohibits the NEA Fund from receiving donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families, will be returned forthwith.

Capitol Club

The UEA Capitol Club is your chance to join a select group of educators who recognize the importance of being involved politically and financially. Capitol Club members understand that voting alone is not enough to elect officials who make the commitment to children and public education, but that it also requires an investment of time and money.

Capitol Club Bronze members contribute at least \$99.00 per year to help elect public education-friendly candidates to office, with at least \$72.00 of that amount designated to U-PAC. Capitol Club Silver members contribute at least \$200.00 per year, with at least \$140.00 of that amount designated to U-PAC. Capitol Club Gold members contribute at least \$250.00 per year, with at least \$175.00 of that amount designated to U-PAC.

Each of the Bronze, Silver and Gold Capitol Club members receive a distinctive lapel pin representative of their contribution level, along with an annual invitation to a special legislative event. More importantly . . . YOU will set an example about the importance of taking an active role in the UEA's political activities.
